

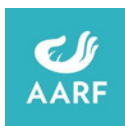

- Accepts strays - unable to take same day; finder will need to hold the animal for 7 days (for intake/application process)

Forsyth County Animal Shelter

- Managed Admission Municipal Shelter
- Accepts stray and surrenders - encourages finder to attempt finding the owner for 48 hours, then make an appointment for intake (if possible)
- Provides pet food pantry

Forsyth Humane Society

- Adoptions, pet surrenders
- Collaborates with Boy Scouts to provide meals to Senior Services Meals on Wheels
- Provides pet food to currently 6 faith based organizations
- Provides education for both adults & children
- Spay/Neuter vouchers, future vaccine clinics in the community
- Cannot accept strays (no room for legal holding period)

PAW Alliance

- New Leash on Life program: 10 week-prison dog-training program where inmates work with the dogs in each class to learn basic obedience, crate and house-training and some agility; dogs are adopted to forever homes at the end of the 10-weeks
- New Start in Life program provides foster (when available) for domestic violence survivor's pets while they seek safety
- Cannot accept strays or surrenders

- Provide spay/neuter vouchers for low-income pet owners and feral cat caretakers
- Owns and operates SpayKind Spay-Neuter Clinic
- Provides spay/neuter services for SpayKind voucher holders, Forsyth County Animal Shelter, nonprofit organizations, and feral cat caretakers.
- Hold mobile pet vaccine clinics in the Triad area - offering rabies and distemper vaccines, microchips and nail trims for dogs and cats
